

Voluntary Planning Agreement	Graymont has entered into a Voluntary Planning Agreement with Hilltops Council, and a VPA Committee has been established to "consider and recommend projects to be implemented by the Council and funded from the Development Contributions" (Commencing at \$0.75/tonne, payable annually and adjusted according to CPI movement).  The annual contribution is based on tonnes of product dispatched and amounts to approximately \$240,000 per annum, a portion of which must be spent in the Galong surroundings.  Under this agreement, these levies are to fund Council projects to maintain and manage haulage routes, improve traffic safety and deliver community and amenity related improvements.  The VPA committee discuss and ratify recommendations from community stakeholders relating to community and amenity related improvements.  The VPA was amended to increase the contribution rate, by Deed of Variation dated 16 August 2022 (as required by conditions of development consent T2003-025 MOD4). The new rate will be implemented once dispatch of 430,000 tonnes is authorised by Hilltops Council.	Ongoing	Quarterly payment of levies
