Calliope Limestone Quarry

Resource activity: Mining activity relating to a mining lease

It is advised that Graymont (Calliope) Pty Ltd has lodged an application for a major amendment to an environmental authority in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*. The environmental authority being amended is EPML00969013.

The application relates to ongoing mining and production of limestone products at the Calliope Limestone Quarry (the Project) located within the Gladstone local government area, approximately 11 kilometres (km) south east of the township of Calliope and approximately 27.5 km south-west of Gladstone. The Project produces approximately 0.8 million tonnes per annum of limestone products and intersects 19 mining leases (MLs) across an area of around 429.7457 hectares. The environmental authority (EA) amendment seeks to update the authorised disturbance areas and post mining land uses currently listed within the EA to reflect intended mining activities until end of mine life, and to modernise the EA to align with in-force legislation. The resource activity is proposed to occur on the following tenure(s) and will involve:

ML3594, ML3595, ML3596, ML3597, ML3598, ML3599, ML3600, ML3602, ML3603, ML3604, ML3605, ML3606, ML3608, ML3609, ML80036, ML80189, ML80190, ML80191, ML80192
